

Abies concolor
White Fir



Form: Pyramidal

Fruit: Cone

Tolerates: Short periods of drought,
Light periods of shade

Growth Rate & Size: Slow-Moderate;
Medium

Native Region: Rocky Mountains,
Western US, Canada

Notes: Grows well in rocky soils;
Slightly more tolerant of urban
conditions than other fir species; Can
withstand periods of heat and cold;
Needles smell like citrus; Beneficial
for birds
